WHAT'S THAT CHRISTMAS CLIP
CONTEST RULES

Contest Basics: During the week of December 12-16, each morning between approximately 7am and 8am EST, The Bert Show will solicit at least one (1) listener to play “What’s that Christmas Clip?” Listeners should call into The Bert Show at 1-855-Bert-Show and The Bert Show will randomly select 1 or more listeners to play.

Game Rules: The Bert Show will play ten (10) short audio clips, each approximately 2 seconds in length, from popular holiday movies. The participant must correctly guess every movie from the clip played in order to win the jackpot. At the end of each run of ten (10) movie clips, the participants will be told how many movies they correct guess. If a participant does not correctly guess all 10 clips, they will be told how many they guessed correctly, but they will not qualify to win the jackpot.

Winning: To win, the participant must guess all ten (10) movie clips correctly in the order in which they are played. The Bert Show shall have the sole discretion in determining the correctness of a participant’s guess and that determination shall be final.

Jackpot: On the first day of the contest, the jackpot starts at \$100. Each day that there is no participant that correctly guesses all 10 movies correctly, the jackpot rolls over to the next. For example, if there is no winner on Monday, then the jackpot on Tuesday is \$200. If a participant wins the jackpot on a particular day, the jackpot for the next day shall be reset to \$100. Total maximum jackpot prize is \$500.
